## FINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Held

MONDAY, JANUARY 30, 2006

The Village Finance committee met at 6:00 PM to discuss 2006 payroll. The following Council members were present:

Brad Rice, Melody Miller, Patricia Graham and John Carpenter.

Also Present: Mayor Tom Longsdorf, Clerk/Treasurer Joanne Clapp, and Board of Public Affairs Robert Geissman.

Employees Present: Police Chief Sivard, Street Commissioner/Utility Superintendent Don Eaken, Fire Chief Roland Jenkin, Rescue Chief Jeremy Patalon, Matt Berry, Jeff Miller, Craig Zdelar, Brian Yost and Pat Higgins.

Rice began the meeting explaining that Sergeant Wes Hornung possibly may retire in July of this year.

Board of Public Affairs member Robert Geissman presented council members with a spread sheet comparing Village utility pay scale with other Village's and where they should be if they were to have received the actual cost of living since year 2000. Clerk/Treasurer Clapp informed council members that the comparisons Village's have a Village Income Tax. Geissman recommended that the employees receive a Cost of Living raise.

Jenkin suggested that Council consider offering Village employee longevity pay.

Chief Sivard informed council members that he was not going to ask for a raise for himself, that council may give his amount of raise to his police officers instead. Chief Sivard requested that council reinstate the uniform allowance of \$500.00 limit for full-time police officers and \$180.00 limit for part-time police officers. Chief Sivard requested the total time for all part-time officers be increase not to exceed 2,000 hours for the pay ordinance period because this would allow him to hire a police officer for training to replace Sergeant Hornung when he retires.


Miller recommended that the Village Council consider hiring a full-time Fire/Rescue Chief.


Rescue Chief Patalon suggested Village Council consider hiring two or three full-time daytime fire/rescue personnel.


Clerk/Treasurer Clapp recommended that two office personnel be made into part-time positions because the of lack work and that the zoning and planning commission secretary be changed from the Administrative Assistant job to Accounts Payable/Payroll Clerk.

Rice explained that the finance committee will be recommending the following to Village Council: a 4.1% pay raise for all employees except no raise for the zoning inspector and fire/rescue hourly employees be paid \$7.00 per hour for runs, meetings and training. Utility employees will be paid \$150.00 per week for being on-call. Employees will receive one additional personnal day.

There being no further business to be brought before the Finance Committees the meeting was adjourned.
