AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2117 OF THE VILLAGE TRAFFIC CODE PROHIBITING TRUCK TRAFFIC ON CERTAIN VILLAGE STREETS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, Council for Village of Lodi, Medina County, Ohio has previously passed Ordinance No. 2117 prohibiting truck traffic on certain Village streets;

WHEREAS, Council now desires to designate a portion of Archer Street as a designated truck route hereby amending Ordinance 2117.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO that:


1. Ordinance No. 2117 is hereby amended to designate a portion of Archer Street between Broadway Street and Maple Grove Street as a designated truck route within the Village.
2. Any part of Ordinance No. 2117 not herein amended remains in full force and effect.
3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Village of Lodi and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency being the immediate need to declare to a portion of Archer Street a designated truck route to allow for the free flow of traffic within the Village; and therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately on upon its passage.
