
AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION GRANT FUNDS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has Neighborhood Revitalization Grant funds available for use with the Villages within Medina County; and


WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the Mayor to make an application for Neighborhood Revitalization Grant funds available from the State of Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO that:


1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application for Neighborhood Revitalization Grant funds that may be available from the State of Ohio.
2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Lodi; the specific reason for the emergency being the immediate need to quickly make application for Neighborhood Revitalization Grant funds that may be available from the State of Ohio and to meet certain deadlines set forth by the State of Ohio, and therefore this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
