
AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO ACCEPTING A GRANT AWARD FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council previously to authorized the Fire Chief to apply for a grant from the Ohio Department of Public Safety for training and patient care equipment; and


WHEREAS, Council now desires to accept said grant.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO that:

1. Council hereby accepts a grant from the Ohio Department of Public Safety for training and patient care equipment. The Fire Chief is hereby authorized to do all things necessary to receive said funds from the Ohio Department of Public Safety.
2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Lodi; the specific reason for the emergency being the immediate need to accept a grant to receive State funds to maintain efficient emergency medical services within the Village, and therefore this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
