**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO
AUTHORIZING THE CLERK TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE
LORAIN-MEDINA RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC. AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY.**


WHEREAS, Council previously authorized the Fire Chief to apply for a grant from the Lorain-Medina Rural Electric Cooperative, Inc. for patient care equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Lorain-Medina Rural Electric Cooperative, Inc. has notified the Village that the Village has been authorized to receive a grant award in the amount of \$2,825.00 for patient care equipment; and


WHEREAS, Council now desires to authorize the Clerk to accept the grant and authorize the Fire Chief to do all things necessary in order to receive the grant.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO that:**

1. The Clerk is hereby authorized to accept a grant from the Lorain-Medina Rural Electric Cooperative, Inc. in the amount of \$2,825.00 for training and patient care equipment. The Fire Chief is hereby authorized to do all things necessary to receive said funds from the Lorain-Medina Rural Electric Cooperative, Inc..
2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Lodi; the specific reason for the emergency being the immediate need to accept the grant to receive funds to maintain efficient emergency medical services within the Village, and therefore this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
