AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO ACCEPTING THE BID OF CARGILL DEICING TECHNOLOGY FOR ICE CONTROL SALT FOR THE VILLAGE STREETS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has received bids, after advertisement, for street salt of ice control salt for the village streets; and


WHEREAS, bids have been reviewed.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO that:


1. The bid of Cargill Deicing Technology is determined to be the lowest and best bid for ice control salt for the village street.
2. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign a contract or purchase order with Cargill Deicing Technology for the following as required by the Village:

500 ton dump truck delivery for FOB Lodi, Ohio \$43.73/ton
3. There shall be no increases in the purchase price and no additional charges shall be assessed during the term of this agreement.
4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Lodi; the specific reason for the emergency being the need to purchase street salt at the earliest date possible in order to provide for safe streets within the Village, and therefore this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
