Special meeting called by Lodi Street Committee chairman John Carpenter for the purpose of discussion of road maintenance coordination with Harrisville Township Trustees.

Called to order at 9:00 AM by John Carpenter

1) Discussed and agreed to continue mutual assistance of snowplowing.

2) Discussion about swapping areas of streets for maintenance.

All parties agreed in principal to attempt a fair and equitable swap of responsibilities for the areas around the intersection of Buffham and Harris roads. We decided to ask Fred Borman (med county highway engineer) to help us deduce a fair split, as he has the footage numbers. We agreed to have another meeting to finalize the plans as soon as we can get the recommendations from Mr. Borman.

3) Discussion about the issues on Garden Isle Road.

Harrisville explained the flooding issue as such. Due to the way everything must be set-up in the area of the old railroad track crossing, all that areas water must drain North. The problem is that the drains under all the tracks are clogged. We are not allowed to clean them out. This maintenance must be done by the railroads involved. We agreed to ask Village Solicitor Ted Lesiak to send a letter to both railroads involved explaining our situation and asking them to clean out the drainage systems under their tracks. This must be done before we can do anything else to repair the drain systems that we are responsible for.
