
**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CLERK TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ALLEN & HARTZELL, INC. AND EMERGENCY SERVICES INSURANCE PROGRAM FOR THE PROVISION OF ACCIDENT INSURANCE FOR VILLAGE FIREFIGHTERS, AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, in the past, the Village of Lodi has provided additional accident insurance for its firefighters; and


**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the Village to enter into a renewal of such insurance with Allen & Hartzell, Inc. and Standard Security Life Insurance Company of New York, in order to continue the provision of accident insurance for village firefighters.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED OF THE COUNCIL** of the Village of Lodi, Medina County, Ohio that:

1. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Allen & Hartzell, Inc. and Standard Security Life Insurance Company of New York for the provision of firefighter's accident insurance pursuant to the terms of the policy attached hereto and marked Exhibit A.
2. The cost of said premium shall not exceed \$1,434.00 for the year 2006.
3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and welfare of the residents of the Village and for the specific purpose of continuing to provide accident insurance for village firefighters and therefore this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
