

# RECORD OF ORDINANCES

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO  
AUTORIZING THE MAYOR TO GIVE CONSENT TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT  
OF TRANSPORTATION TO REPLACE TWO BRIDGES IN AND NEAR THE  
VILLAGE OF LODI AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio Department of Transportation has plans to replace two bridges in and near the Village of Lodi; and


**AND WHEREAS**, the Ohio Department of Transportation has requested that Lodi give consent for the replacement of these structures.


**AND WHEREAS**, Council now desires to authorize the Mayor to give consent on behalf of the Village for the replacement of two bridges in and near the Village of Lodi.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE  
VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:**

1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to give consent on behalf of the Village of Lodi for the replacement of two structures on State Route 83 in Medina County, including a 17' foot deficient structure south of the Village of Lodi, over the Killbuck Creek and a 15' foot structure over the Whetstone Creek, between Greenwich Road and Anderson Street within the Village of Lodi. The project includes other miscellaneous construction items.
2. The Village of Lodi shall cooperate with the Ohio Department of Transportation in the above described project as follows:
  - A. The Village of Lodi hereby gives consent for the above improvements.
  - B. No funds are required from the Village of Lodi, except that the Village agrees to assume and bear one hundred (100%) percent of the total cost for added construction items requested by the Village of Lodi and not necessary for the improvement as determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration.
  - C. The Village of Lodi agrees that all right of way required in the Village for the described project will be made available in accordance with the current State and Federal regulations.
  - D. The Village of Lodi agrees to maintain the right of way within the Village and keep it free of obstructions, and hold said right of way within the Village inviolate for public highway purposes.
3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, safety and well-being of the inhabitants of the Village of Lodi; the specific reason for the emergency being the immediate need to upgrade highways in and near the Village to promote public safety and therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
