Ordinance No. 2653-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, ACCEPTING THE BID OF MONTROSE FORD FOR A POLICE CRUISER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Lodi has previously authorized advertisement of bids specifications for a police cruiser; and

WHEREAS, bidders have submitted their bids; and

WHEREAS, Montrose Ford submitted a bid in compliance with the bid specifications as advertised; and


WHEREAS, Council has determined that the bid of Montrose Ford is the lowest and best bid of the bids submitted.

WHEREAS, Council now desires to accept the bid without the provision of the police radio which will be obtained from another source.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Lodi, Medina County, Ohio that:


1. The bid of Montrose Ford is determined to be the lowest and best bid for a police cruiser as defined in the bid specifications and contract documents.
2. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Montrose Ford to furnish a completed police cruiser for the price of up to \$20,709.43.
3. All of the terms and conditions of the bid specifications and contract documents are hereby expressly incorporated into the contract which is attached hereto and marked Exhibit A.
4. The Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health, safety and the benefit of the Village of Lodi and its inhabitants, the specific reason being the need to obtain new police equipment for the safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Lodi and therefore this Ordinance shall be effective from the date of passage.
