Ordinance No. 2660-06

Passed April 17, 2006, _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO REQUESTING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO CERTIFY THE CURRENT TAX VALUATION IN THE SUBDIVISION AND THE AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE PRODUCED BY THREE (3) MILLS, LEVY A TAX OUTSIDE THE TEN (10) MILL LIMITATION FOR CURRENT OPERATING ASSESSEMENTS TO BE PLACED ON THE BALLOT AT THE NOVEMBER 7, 2006 ELECTION AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Lodi has determined that due to lower revenues, a replacement levy is necessary to be placed upon the ballot for the November 7, 2006 general election; and


WHEREAS, Council now desires to authorize the Clerk to do all things necessary to place said levy upon the ballot.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO that:

1. The Clerk is hereby authorized to all things necessary to place a five (5) year replacement levy upon the ballot at the November 7, 2006. The Clerk shall request that the County Auditor's certified the current tax valuation of the Village and the amount of revenue that would be produced by three (3) mills, to levy a tax outside the ten (10) mill limitation for the current operating expenses of the Village.
2. The Village of Lodi hereby declares that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten (10) mill limitation.
3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety and welfare of the Village of Lodi and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency being the immediate need to place a five (5) year replacement levy upon the November 7, 2006 to receive more revenue to continue to provide services provided by the Village of Lodi, and therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
