AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, ACCEPTING THE BID OF LYTLE CONSTRUCTION INC. FOR MATERIAL AND LABOR AS IDENTIFIED HEREIN FOR STREET REPAIRS AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village annually repairs streets and is therefore in need of certain material and labor relative to the installation of the material and labor relative to the installation of the material specified herein; and


WHEREAS, the Council advertised specifications and received bids and have now reviewed the bids as submitted; and

WHEREAS, the bid of LYTLE CONSTRUCTION INC. is determined by Council to be the lowest and best bid submitted for the material and labor described herein; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT OBTAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:


1. LYTLE CONSTRUCTION INC. is hereby determined to be the lowest and best bidder for the materials and labor described in the following paragraph.
2. The labor and material is described as follows:

a. Scarifying and pulverizing road materials to less than 3"	\$96.00 per hour
b. #67 Limestone for base	\$16.50 per ton
c. #8 or #6 Limestone for sealing	\$19.15 per ton
d. MC-30 or MC-70 (10,000 gallons more or less) Furnished and applied.	\$1.76 per gallon
e. MC-3000 (10,000 gallons more or less) Furnished and applied.	\$1.60 per gallon
3. The material shall be supplied and the application shall be performed by LYTLE CONSTRUCTION INC. pursuant to the direction of the Superintendent of the Street Department.
4. All material shall be furnished and delivered pursuant to the specifications previously advertised by the Village. The quantities of materials set forth are approximate amounts only and shall be subject to increase or decrease, at the same unit price as stated in the bid, all pursuant to the direction of the Superintendent of the Street Department.
5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, safety, and well being of the Community of Lodi and its inhabitants, the specific reason for the emergency being the need to enter into contracts or issue purchase orders at the earliest possible date in order to accommodate street repair work needed by the Village of the earliest possible time in which takes into account the weather.
