AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO ACCEPTING THE BID OF THE PUBLIC ENTITIES POOL OF OHIO FOR THE PURCHASE OF LIABILITY AND CASUALTY INSURANCE FOR THE VILLAGE OF LODI AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CLERK TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE PUBLIC ENTITIES POOL OF OHIO FOR THE SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, the current contract for the provision of liability insurance to the Village of Lodi will imminently expire; and

WHEREAS, council has advertised specifications and received bids for liability and insurance for the Village of Lodi and have now reviewed the bids as submitted; and

WHEREAS, the bid of the Public Entities Pool of Ohio has been determined by council to be the lowest and best bid submitted for the provision of liability and casualty insurance for The Village of Lodi.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

1. The bid of the Public Entities Pool of Ohio for the provision of liability and casualty insurance for the Village of Lodi for the period of one year from May 16, 2006 is determined to be the lowest and best bid pursuant to the specifications.
2. The Mayor and the Clerk/Treasurer are hereby authorized to enter into a participating agreement with the Public Entities Pool of Ohio which will provide liability and casualty insurance coverage for the Village in accordance with the proposal which is incorporated herein by reference. The total premium shall not exceed \$35,473.00.
3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, safety and well being of the community of Lodi and its inhabitants; particular emergency being the immediate need to maintain liability and casualty insurance for the benefit of The Village of Lodi and therefore this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
