
AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR COMMUNITY BLOCK GRANT FUNDS TO THE BENEFIT OF THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Medina County has informed the Village of Lodi that the State of Ohio has Community Block Grant funds available for use within the County and the local townships and villages within Medina County, and


WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the Mayor to make application for Community Block Grant FY2006 for funds available from the State of Ohio, Department of Development through Medina County, Ohio.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO that:

1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application for Community Block Grant FY2006 for funds that may be available from the State of Ohio, Department of Development through Medina County, Ohio.
2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety, health and welfare of the Village of Lodi and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency being the need to quickly make application for Community Block Grant funds that may be available from the State of Ohio and to meet certain deadlines set forth by the Medina County Commissioners, and therefore this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
