

# RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 2678-06

Passed May 15, 2006

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NOS. 2376 AND 2388 OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO ASSESSING COPY CHARGES FOR REQUESTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR PUBLIC AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, Ohio law permits the Village of Lodi to charge for copies of public documents and mailings costs; and


**WHEREAS**, Council of the Village of Lodi previously established a rate policy for copy requests of public documents from the Village of Lodi; and


**WHEREAS**, Council now desires to repeal said Ordinances to charge a reduced flat fee per page to encompass all the actual costs to the Village of Lodi relating to the production of documents, including, mailing costs while complying with the Ohio Revised Code.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO that:**

1. Ordinance Nos. 2376 and 2388 are hereby repealed, and upon the effective date of this Ordinance, requests for copies of public documents from the Village of Lodi, Medina County, Ohio shall be charged at the rate of \$0.05 per copy.
2. The rates set forth above are established by the actual costs necessary to provide copying materials, equipment and mailing costs, upon a public document request in compliance with the Ohio Revised Code.
3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety and welfare of the Village of Lodi and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency being the immediate need to establish copy charges for public requests for information, and therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
