
AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CLERK TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTS WITH THE MEDINA COUNTY SHERIFF FOR DISPATCH SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Lodi desires to authorize the Mayor and the Clerk to enter in to contracts for dispatch services with the Medina County Sheriff ; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO that:

1. The Mayor and the Clerk are authorized and directed to enter into dispatch contracts with the Medina County Sheriff for emergency dispatching needs and communications of the Village. Said contract is attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A".
2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Lodi; the specific reason for the emergency being the immediate need to insure the continuity of dispatch for emergencies within the Village, and therefore this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
