**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2495 ESTABLISHING A RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR ALL FIRE FIGHTERS AND RESCUE PERSONNEL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, Lodi Village Council has previously adopted Rules and Regulations for the Lodi Fire Department Rules as amended; and

**WHEREAS**, Council has previously established a residency requirement for all personnel of the Fire and Rescue Department to promote safety in responding to calls within the Fire and Rescue Departments coverage area; and

**WHEREAS**, Council now desires to amend the residency requirement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:**


1. The residency requirement contained in the Lodi Fire Department and Rescue Department Rules and Regulations is hereby amended as follows:


RESIDENCY

All members of the Lodi Fire Department and/or Rescue Department shall reside within the Lodi Fire Department and Rescue Department coverage area; specifically, the Village of Lodi, Ohio and Harrisville Township, Ohio. This Ordinance is not retroactive.

2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety and welfare of the Village of Lodi and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency being the immediate need to amend the residency requirement of the Fire and Rescue Departments, and therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
