AN ORDINANCE AND JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO AND THE LODI BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2453 CHARGING THE LODI UTILITY DEPARTMENTS FOR UTILITY USAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Lodi, Medina County, Ohio and Lodi Board of Public Affairs previously authorized the Clerk Treasurer to issue charges to the Lodi Water, Sewer and Electric departments for utility usage in each of the departments in Ordinance No.²⁴⁵³; and

WHEREAS, Council and the Board of Public Affairs desire to repeal Ordinance No. 2453 .

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO AND THE LODI BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS that:

- 1. Ordinance No. 2453 is hereby repealed in total.
- 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Lodi and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency being the need to immediately discontinue charges to the Lodi utility departments for their use of utility services. Therefore this Ordinance and Joint Resolution shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage.
