AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE OHIO DIVISION OF EMS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Lodi, previously authorized the EMS Chief to apply for a grant from the Ohio Division of EMS to provide for funds for training and equipment; and


WHEREAS, the Ohio Division of EMS has provided the Village with the grant of funds for training and equipment and Council desires to accept the grant with specifications contained therein.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO that:

1. The Mayor, Clerk and the EMS Chief are hereby authorized and directed to accept a grant from the Ohio Division of EMS for funds for training and equipment for the Lodi EMS Squad.
2. The Village of Lodi shall comply with the terms and conditions of the grant as are contained herein in Exhibit A.
3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and benefit of the Village of Lodi and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency being the immediate need to provide funds for training and equipment for the Lodi EMS Squad to enable that department to continue to protect and serve the public and comply with legal reporting requirements, and therefore this ordinance shall be effective at the earliest date permitted by law.
