
AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Lodi desires to authorize the Chief of Police to accept a grant from the Bulletproof Vest Partnership to obtain bulletproof vests for Village police officers.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO that:

1. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to accept a grant from the Bulletproof Vest Partnership to obtain bulletproof vests for Village police officers.
2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Lodi and its inhabitants, the specific reason for the emergency and being the need to immediately accept the grant to possibly obtain bulletproof vests for the police department, and therefore this Ordinance shall be effective from the date of passage.
