Ordinance No. 2691-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO AMENDING THE LODI FIRE DEPARTMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS TO DEFINE AN ACTIVE MEMBER AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2669-06 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village of Lodi has previously established Lodi Fire Department Rules and Regulations; and

WHEREAS, Council now desires to amend the previously established ordinance and enact a new ordinance to determine the definition of an "Active Member" of the Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

1. Ordinance No. 2669-06 is hereby amended as follows:
2. "Active Member" for the Lodi Fire Department shall be defined as a Firefighter of the Lodi Fire Department who attends Seventy 70% of all regularly scheduled Lodi Fire meetings and training sessions in a three (3) month period beginning July 1, 2006. Probationary Firefighters must attend 100% of all regularly scheduled Lodi Rescue meetings and training sessions during the probationary period.
3. Beginning July 1, 2006, training records and call records shall be reviewed at the first Officer's Meeting of each quarter by the Officers of the Department. Any Firefighter not complying with the requirements set forth in Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be immediately removed as a "Active Member" of the Department for a period of three (3) months. Any probationary Firefighter not complying with the requirements set forth in Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be immediately removed from the Department.
4. During the three (3) month period that any Firefighter is removed as an active member of the Department, any inactive Firefighter shall attend Seventy (70%) of all regularly scheduled Lodi Fire Meetings and Training Sessions during the three (3) month period. If any inactive Firefighter fails to attend Seventy (70%) percent of all regularly scheduled Lodi Fire Meetings and Training Sessions during the three (3) month period, the inactive Firefighter shall be immediately removed from the Department.
5. The Chief of the Lodi Fire Department shall post an "Active Member" and "Inactive Member" list immediately following the first Officer's Meeting of each quarter at the Fire Department Headquarters. The Chief of the Lodi Fire Department shall also notify any Firefighter who is not an active member of the Department, or who has been removed from the Department in a writing mailed to the last known address of the Firefighter kept in the payroll records with the Village with a copy to the Village Safety Director.
6. Any Firefighter who is unable to comply with the requirements of Section 2 of this Ordinance may request a leave in writing from the Lodi Fire Chief. Any leave requested must be approved in writing by the Lodi Fire Chief in order to be effective. All requests for leave and approvals or denials of leave shall be retained in the employee's personnel file. Any Firefighter on the "Inactive Member" list and subject to a Physical and/or Training Expense Contract attached as Exhibit "A" to Ordinance No. 2668-06 shall have the contract term extended for the length of the inactive period.
7. Any provision of Ordinance No. 2669-06 not herein modified shall remain in full force and effect.


