**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF THE 2000 FORD VICTORIA POLICE CRUISER TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT ACADEMY AT THE MEDINA COUNTY JOINT VOCATIONAL SCHOOL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, Council of the Village of Lodi has determined that the 2000 Ford Victoria police cruiser is no longer needed for municipal purposes; and


**WHEREAS**, the Medina County Joint Vocational School's Law Enforcement Academy has inquired as to the availability of police cruisers no longer needed for municipal purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, Council of the Village of Lodi now desires to donate the 2000 Ford Victoria police cruiser to the Medina County Joint Vocational School's Law Enforcement Academy.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Lodi, Medina County, Ohio that:**


1. The 2000 Ford Victoria police cruiser no longer needed for municipal purposes is hereby donated to the Medina County Joint Vocational School's Law Enforcement Academy.
2. The Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and the benefit of the Village of Lodi and its inhabitants, the specific reason being the need to donate a police cruiser no longer needed for municipal purposes to the Medina County Joint Vocational School's Law Enforcement Academy prior to the beginning of the 2006-2007 school year and therefore this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
