Ordinance No. 2696-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH OHIO INSURANCE SERVICES AGENCY, INC. FOR COBRA ADMINISTRATION AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Lodi provides health insurance for its employees; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Insurance Services Agency, Inc. offers a COBRA administration contract whereby Ohio Insurance Agency, Inc. will administer all COBRA notifications and billing upon an employees termination from employment; and


WHEREAS, council desires to authorize the Mayor and the Clerk to enter into the COBRA administration contract with Ohio Insurance Agency, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, that:


SECTION I: The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into a COBRA administration contract with Ohio Insurance Service Agency, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$650.00 for the term of August 1, 2006 until July 31, 2007. A copy of the COBRA Administration Contract is attached hereto and made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A".


SECTION II: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the immediate passage of which is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the residents of the Village of Lodi, the specific emergency being the need to provide COBRA administration services for employees termination from employment with the Village and therefore this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
