AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CLERK TO APPLY FOR OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION ISSUE II GRANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission Issue II program has grant funds available for the repair and replacement of municipal infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, Council now desires to authorize the Mayor and the Clerk to apply for grants from such program for storm sewer siltation basin rehabilitation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, that


1. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized to apply for grant funds from the Ohio Public Works Commission Issue II program for storm sewer siltation basin rehabilitation.
2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, safety, health and welfare of the community of Lodi and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency being the immediate need to apply for grant funds to repair infrastructure within the Village and therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
