AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2655-06 FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council previously adopted a pay Ordinance which became effective February 5, 2006; and

WHEREAS, Council now desires to amend Section VII of the Ordinance regarding Street Department Employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

1. The current pay Ordinance as referenced above is hereby modified as follows:

SECTION VII: STREET DEPARTMENT


Overtime, as authorized by the Superintendent of the Board or Mayor, shall be compensated at a rate of one and one-half (1 ½) times the hourly rate after forty (40) hours per week and paid per regular payroll bi-weekly. Any employee called to return for an emergency shall receive a minimum of one (1) hour of compensation.


2. This amendment to the 2006 Payroll Ordinance shall be retroactive to August 2, 2006.


3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety and welfare of the Village of Lodi and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency being the immediate need to make the Lodi pay ordinance consistent in all departments within the Village, and therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
