Ordinance No. 2699-06

Passed 9-18-06, _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK TO ENTER INTO A RENEWAL CONTRACT OR PURCHASE ORDER WITH ANTHEM BLUE CROSS AND BLUE SHIELD FOR THE PURCHASE OF MEDICAL INSURANCE FOR THE VILLAGE OF LODI, OHIO, AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Lodi, Medina County, Ohio, previously adopted a pay ordinance providing for medical insurance coverage for Village employees; and

WHEREAS, council now desires to renew the contract with Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield as the best medical insurance provider available; and

WHEREAS, council also desires to maintain the requirement that employees pay 10% of the monthly medical insurance premium beginning with the November 2004 billing invoice.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, that:


SECTION I: The contract of Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield is hereby renewed and determined to be the best provider of medical insurance for the Village employees.

SECTION II: The Clerk and Mayor are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract or purchase order with Anthem Blue Cross & Blue Shield, for the purchase of medical insurance as defined in the specifications previously adopted by the Village.


SECTION III: The Village shall require all employees to pay 10% of the monthly medical insurance premium to be accomplished through payroll deduction beginning September 15, 2006. The cost to each employee shall be \$28.32, per pay period, for single coverage and \$43.63, per pay period, for family coverage.


SECTION IV: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the immediate passage of which is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the residents of the Village of Lodi, the specific emergency being the need to maintain and continue medical insurance coverage for the Village employees.
