Ordinance No. 2705-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT WITH VALLEY FORD TRUCK FOR A FORD F750 DUMP TRUCK WITH A SNOW PLOW AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Lodi has previously authorized the Street Superintendent to obtain quotes for a snow plow and dump truck; and


WHEREAS, Valley Ford Truck submitted a quote in compliance with the Street Department specifications; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that the Mayor and the Clerk shall enter into a contract with Valley Ford Truck for said snow plow and dump truck.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Lodi, Medina County, Ohio that:


1. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Valley Ford Truck for a snow plow and Ford 750 Dump Truck. The price for said snow plow and dump truck shall not exceed \$84,310.00.
2. The Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health, safety and the benefit of the Village of Lodi and its inhabitants, the specific reason being the need to obtain at the best price possible a new dump truck for the Street Department prior to the winter season and for the safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Lodi and therefore this Ordinance shall be effective from the date of passage.
