Ordinance No. 2715-06

Passed 12-18-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, REQUESTING THE AUDITOR OF MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO TO MAKE TAX ADVANCES FOR THE YEAR 2007 PURSUANT TO SECTION 321.34 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, Section 321.34 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the County Auditor to make tax advances and distributions to municipalities in the current year; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Lodi is desirous of receiving their share of taxes from the County Auditor at the earliest possible date.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, that:


1. The Auditor of Medina County, Ohio is hereby requested to make available and to cause distribution to the Village of Lodi, Medina County, Ohio, such funds to which the Village of Lodi is entitled, pursuant to Section 321.34 of the Ohio Revised Code, at the earliest possible date.
2. This request is deemed to be a continuing request for the year 2007 so as to result in distribution of funds to the Village of Lodi at such times during 2007 that any money is available to the Village of Lodi and is lawfully applicable for the purpose of the current fiscal year in which request is made.
3. The Clerk/Treasurer of the Village of Lodi is hereby authorized and directed to submit a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Auditor of Medina County, Ohio and is further directed and empowered to do all things necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Ordinance.
4. This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and the welfare of the residents of the Village of Lodi. The specific reason for the emergency being that the Village will benefit from receipt of funds to its credit at the earliest possible date thereby having funds available for use for Village purposes and the further benefit being the accrual of interest of the Village, and therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage.
