AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO EXTENDING THE CONTRACT OF THE VILLAGE PROSECUTOR FOR ANOTHER YEAR, COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2007 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, Page Schrock is presently under contract with the Village of Lodi to provide services as the Village Prosecutor for the year 2006; and


WHEREAS, The Village requires the continuing services of a prosecutor; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO that:

1. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Page Schrock under the terms as set forth in the proposed contract attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Lodi and its inhabitants; and arising out of the need to have a prosecutor represent the Village of Lodi in Village prosecutions commencing January 1, 2007, and therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.

CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT is entered into this 18th day of December, 2006, by and between the Village of Lodi, Medina County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as "Village", and Page Schrock, III, hereinafter referred to as "Police Prosecutor".

WITNESSETH:

In consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

1. The Village shall compensate the Police Prosecutor for his services as defined herein, at a monthly salary of \$ 857.39 Dollars (\$ 857.39) per month, payable at the end of each month.
2. The term of this contract shall be from January 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007.
3. The Police Prosecutor shall provide the Village with all usual and ordinary services required by the laws of the State of Ohio, and the ordinances of the Village of Lodi. Specifically, the Police Prosecutor shall be responsible for all Village prosecutions in the Wadsworth Municipal Court. In addition, the Police Prosecutor shall be available for consultation with Police officials and the Mayor, relative to arrests, investigations, and prosecutions.
4. The parties agree that this relationship is a part-time relationship and shall terminate on December 31, 2007, unless renewed by appropriate legislation.
