A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO AMENDING ^{Resolution} ORDINANCE NO. 1550 ESTABLISHING WATER CHARGES PURSUANT TO SECTION 735.29 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE; AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees of Public Affairs of the Village of Lodi is authorized by statute to establish water charges pursuant to Section 735.29 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees of Public Affairs of the Village of Lodi has deemed it necessary to amend ^{Resolution} Ordinance No. 1550, relative to water charges with regard use of water during construction; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO that:


1. ^{Resolution} Ordinance No. 1550 is hereby amended as follows:


Any new development that is not currently a customer of the Village Water Department, shall pay to the Village the current tap-in fee and a meter shall be installed before any water services shall be provided during the construction of any commercial or industrial development. Upon the provision of water service to said commercial or industrial customer, said customer shall pay the rate for water service currently in effect at the time the water service has commenced. There shall be a Fifty (\$50.00) Dollar fee for water service provided to any residential lot during construction upon said residential lot.


2. Any water rate Resolution, not herein modified shall remain in full force and effect.


3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, safety, and welfare of the Village of Lodi and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency being the need to establish reasonable charges for water service during construction in the Village's water service area, and therefore this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
