A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO RATIFYING A UNILATERAL CHANGE TO AN ELECTRIC SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH CLOVERLEAF LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT AND CONFIRMING THE RETURN TO THE TERMS OF THE ORIGINAL AGREEMENT AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, On February 26, 1998, the Village of Lodi Board of Public Affairs entered into a contract with the Cloverleaf Local School District to extend electric service and provide electric service to the Cloverleaf Local School District now relocated at County Road 35 and County Road 72, Westfield Township, Ohio; and


WHEREAS, As of July 7, 2000, the Village of Lodi Board of Public Affairs unilaterally reduced the rates charged to the Cloverleaf School District pursuant to said Agreement; and


WHEREAS, the unilateral reduction of rates was overlooked in the minutes of the Lodi Board of Public Affairs meeting of July, 2000, and therefore, the Board now desires to accept and ratify the previous lowering of rates charged to the Cloverleaf Local School District; and


WHEREAS, the Board now desires to return to the original rate terms contained in the Agreement dated February 26, 1998.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS OF THE VILLAGE OF LODI, MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO that:


1. The defacto rate change which lowered the rates contained in the February 26, 1998 Agreement between the Lodi Board of Public Affairs and the Cloverleaf Local School District is hereby affirmed and ratified as of July 7, 2000.
2. As of the ^{August 16} ~~July~~ 2006 billing, the Clerk is hereby authorized to charge the rate set forth in the original Agreement of February 26, 1998 between the Lodi Board of Public Affairs and the Cloverleaf Local School District.
3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, safety, and welfare of the Village of Lodi and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency being the need to correct past unilateral rate changes pursuant to an agreement with the Cloverleaf Local School Districts, and therefore this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
